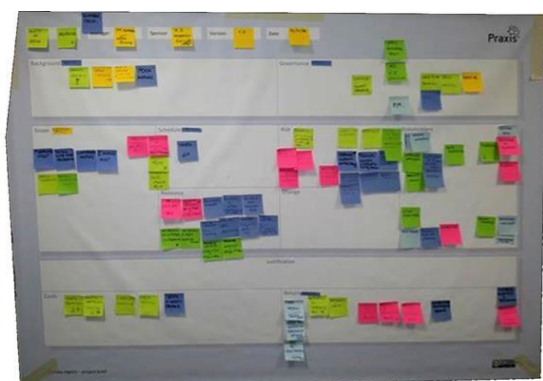
Marco Re – Project Management Consultant
